Lynnae N. made a motion to sell leftovers to parishioners only, while everything else is free-will donation. The motion was seconded by Val F. Motion carried.

- † Pascha Flowers Julie W. ordered the flowers for the tomb and Bev K. will set out them out for Friday's 3:00 service. Lynnae N. and Sue D. will decorate the plaschanitsa.

- † Easter Egg Hunt The Easter Egg Hunt will take place on Sunday, April 27th. The Youth Group will take care of dying the eggs for the kids.
- † Pentecost We will be having our annual chicken dinner and potluck on June 8^{th.} We will be adding hot dogs for the kids and JoAnn S. will increase our order to 150 pieces of chicken. Russell Collins will be baptized on that day, also. Val F. may make a cake.
